Objectives:

Utilizing allegations of abuse, neglect and exploitation (ANE) of a vulnerable adult:

1. Analyze the facts known at the time to determine if they meet the definitions of ANE in Title 43, Chapter 35.
2. Describe the necessary reporting requirements as outlined in Title 43, Chapter 35.
3. Distinguish the necessary investigative steps to address this allegation of ANE, and clarify and understand the role of investigators and that of other mandatory reporters.
4. Formulate a response to the incident that protects the victim, meets the needs of the victim and holds the offender accountable.
